The mission of the Kitt Peak Visitor Center is to inspire a sense of wonder and awe about the Universe, through exhibits, tours and public programs.

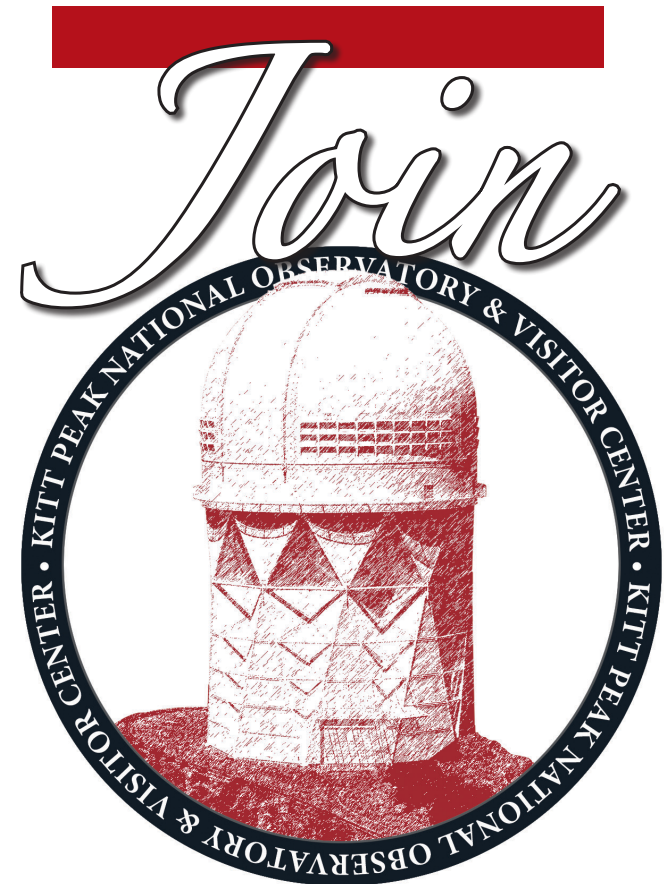
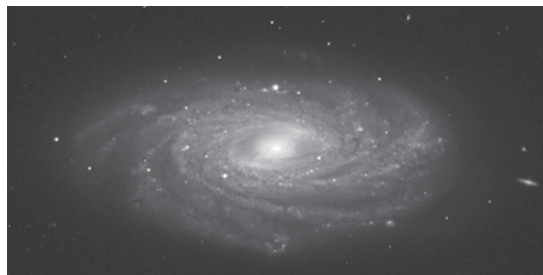

Founded in 1958 as the US national observatory, Kitt Peak has been a world-famous center for astronomical research for over 50 years. Nestled on top of Kitt Peak in the Quinlin Mountains on the Tohono O'odham Nation, it is the world's largest observatory with more than 25 different telescopes used for research and public outreach.

The Kitt Peak Visitor Center, built in 1964, has been conducting public programs for over 49 years. The Visitor Center is the hub for public access to the mountain. From exhibits to special events and programs to nightly stargazing, the Visitor Center brings you closer to the amazing world of astronomy.

Kitt Peak is managed within the National Optical Astronomy Observatory by AURA under a cooperative agreement with the National Science Foundation.
